Affordable Housing Application Open – Townhomes Available in Grays Ferry

Construction on the Arlene Thorpe Townhomes will wrap up this spring

PHILADELPHIA – New affordable townhomes from the Women's Community Revitalization Project (WCRP) will be completed this spring and applications are now open for interested rental tenants. The Arlene Thorpe Townhomes are being built in Philadelphia's Grays Ferry neighborhood and will consist of seven one-bedrooms, 10 two-bedrooms, and 10 three-bedrooms. Interested tenants <u>can apply here</u>.

All townhomes will include central air, stove, refrigerator, washer/dryer, garbage disposal, and common space for tenant activities. Six of the homes will be wheelchair accessible and two are being built with specific accessibility features for persons with hearing or visual disabilities. The complex is close to shopping on Grays Ferry Avenue and was intentionally designed to fit into the surrounding neighborhood.

With a particular focus on low-income women and their families, WCRP strives to increase equity through the development of affordable housing in Philadelphia. The organization involves residents and neighbors in their design to ensure housing meets the real-life needs of the families who live there. WCRP will offer supportive services to tenants of the Arlene Thorpe Townhomes to help them achieve family and financial goals. The organization also acts as property managers, handling leases and maintenance.
