Affordable Housing Application Open – Townhomes Available in West Philadelphia

Construction on the Abigail Pankey Townhomes will wrap up in early 2026

PHILADELPHIA – Applications for rental tenants are now open for upcoming affordable housing apartments from The Women's Community Revitalization Project (WCRP). The Abigail Pankey Apartments are being built in West Philadelphia's Mantua neighborhood and expected to be completed in early 2026. The apartment complex will consist of 32 units including 22 two-bedrooms and 10 three-bedrooms, all suited for families with children. Interested tenants <u>can apply here</u>.

All apartments will include central air conditioning, in-unit laundry, and free wi-fi. The complex will offer a small parking area, elevators, 24-hour on-call maintenance, and a common space for tenants. Eight apartments will be fully accessible for individuals with disabilities and two will be sensory units designed for individuals with hearing and visual differences.

With a particular focus on low-income women and their families, WCRP strives to increase equity through the development of affordable housing in Philadelphia. The organization involves residents and neighbors in their design planning to ensure housing meets the real-life needs of the women and families who live there. WCRP will offer supportive services to tenants of the Abigail Pankey Apartments to help them achieve personal, family, and financial goals while acting as property managers handling leases, rent, and maintenance to ensure excellent living conditions.
